ORDER RE PREHEARING CONFERENCE ON OBJECTION TO CLAIM

It is ordered that a PREHEARING CONFERENCE be held on at the United States Bankruptcy Court, Rm

COUNSEL FOR THE OBJECTOR (OR THE OBJECTOR, IF UNREPRESENTED BY COUNSEL) is ordered to serve this **PREHEARING CONFERENCE ORDER** on the Claimant within seven calendar days from the date of this Order.
