6. Remaining Matters on Confirmation Calendar:

1 – SPORLEDER – 07-5-1492

Re: Amazing Packaging & NC Two, LP – Objections not resolved, per PHS.

PYMT ORDER: Case dismissed with stay through 2/5 @ 4pm for payment of \$1,000 to be received by Trustee.

Trustee's position: This is the 7th prehearing. The Court advised the parties at the 11/13 PHC that it was inclined to dismiss the matter if there was no progress; however, **the Trustee defers to the Court's discretion in this matter.** The debtors and their real estate agent filed declarations on 1/7 and 1/8, respectively, as requested by the Court on 11/13, outlining the efforts made to market the debtors' residence. The Trustee requests that a payment order be issued in the amount noted above.

2 – BECKER – 07-5-1759

Re: MTGLQ – Parties filed a Joint Statement of Issues in Dispute on 1/8.

Re: Trustee – Objection withdrawn; however, if an agreement is reached with creditor, an Amended Plan may need to be filed, in which case, the Trustee requests additional time to review it.

Trustee position: This is the 11th prehearing. The Court advised the parties at the 11/13 PHC that the issues must be resolved by this hearing or a hearing will be set; however, **the Trustee defers to the Court's discretion in this matter.**

3 – AGUIAR – 07-5-4008

Re: R. & K. Walker – Current status of the objection filed 1/14/08 is unknown, as the PHS is unchanged from the 11/13 PHS. Debtors are requesting another 60 day continuance in order to resolve the adversary proceeding.

Re: Trustee – Counsel and the Trustee conferred on 11/6 regarding a resolution of the objection; however, no amendments have yet been filed.

SCHED ORDER: Case dismissed with stay through 2/26 for debtor to –

File an Amended Plan, or other appropriate amendments, that will resolve all points of the 3rd Amended Trustee objection filed 7/8.

Trustee position: This is the 7th prehearing. **The Trustee defers to the Court’s discretion in this matter;** however, if the matter is continued, the Trustee requests that a scheduling order be issued as noted above.

4 – MERCHANT – 07-5-4236 (also #128)

Re: Bay FCU – Debtor stipulated for relief from stay and has elected to surrender the vehicle; however, an Amended Plan has not yet been filed.

Re: IRS – Per PHS, the debtor’s tax returns have been filed; however, the objection has not been withdrawn.

Re: MERS – PHS does not address; however, it appears that the adversary proceeding is still pending.

Re: Trustee – Objection filed 8/11 remains unresolved.

PYMT ORDER: Case dismissed with stay through 2/5 @ 4pm for payment of \$1,680 to be received by Trustee.

Trustee’s position: The debtor has not made a plan payment since 7/08 and the PHS states that she has ceased communicating with her attorney. This matter was continued from 8/21 in order to allow time for resolution of the adversary proceeding. **It does not appear that the debtor is prosecuting her case.**

6 – JOHANSEN – 08-5-0743

Re: Kenwood Crosspointe HOA – Per PHS, debtor believes that the 2nd Amended Plan resolves this objection; however, the objection has not been withdrawn as of 1/12.

Trustee position: The matter is in a position to be **confirmed if the objection is withdrawn or overruled.**

7 – STREAM – 08-5-0840

Re: Wen Chow, et al – The debtor is requesting another 120 day continuance to track with adversary 08-5-05126; however, it is unclear what progress is being made. Debtor's PHS again states that all cross-defendants were served in the adversary, but have not retained counsel or filed responsive pleadings.

Re: Trustee – Objection filed 3/28 remains unresolved.

PYMT ORDER: Case dismissed with stay through 2/5 @ 4pm for payment of \$400 to be received by Trustee.

Trustee position: The debtor has not made a plan payment since 10/08 (current through 9/08.) The **Trustee will defer to the Court's discretion**, but requests that a payment order be issued in the amount noted above.

10 – JOPLIN – 08-5-1376

Re: Robert & Mary Westover – The debtor is requesting another 90 day continuance to resolve this objection and the related adversary.

PYMT ORDER: Case dismissed with stay through 2/5 @ 4pm for payment of \$247 to be received by Trustee.

Trustee position: The **Trustee will defer to the Court's discretion**, but requests that a payment order be issued in the amount noted above.

Re: Almogelas – The debtor is requesting a continuance to a date no earlier than 4/16. The debtor’s PHS states that this objection cannot be resolved until the adversary proceeds to trial or is settled. An appraisal of the real property has been completed and a realtor chosen.

Trustee position: The **Trustee does not oppose a continuance.**

21 – REYES – 08-5-2639

Re: Trustee – The second Amended Trustee objection filed 9/22 is unresolved and the debtor is only current through September.

Trustee position: The debtor filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss his case on 10/29, to which the Trustee filed a limited objection. The Court instructed debtor’s counsel at the hearing on 11/13 to file a copy of the request for dismissal which bore the debtor’s “wet” signature. As of the hearing on 12/11, this document had not been filed. On 12/23 the debtor filed another motion to voluntarily dismiss. This motion is dated 11/13, which is the same date that debtor’s attorney was ordered to produce a wet copy of the motion to dismiss which was filed on 10/29. In addition, the motion filed on 12/23 appears to have a stamped signature of debtor’s attorney. To date, no wet copy of debtor’s motion to dismiss filed on 10/29 has been produced. However, it does appear that debtor signed the motion to dismiss which was filed on 12/23 and the debtor is not prosecuting his case which would indicate that the debtor does not wish to remain in Chapter 13. The **Trustee no longer opposes the debtor’s motion to voluntarily dismiss.**

23 – MENDOZA-FARSHEEDI – 08-5-2697

Re: Bad Boys Bail Bonds – PHS only states that this objection is being litigated in the ongoing adversary proceeding, but does not request a continued date.

Trustee position: The **Trustee does not oppose a continuance.**

31 – FONG – 08-5-3007

Re: SMW 104 FCU – Per PHS, debtors believe that the Amended Plan resolves this objection; however, the objection has not been withdrawn as of 1/12.

Trustee position: The matter is in a position to be **confirmed if the objection is withdrawn or overruled.**

44 – PASSINO / ANDERSON – 08-5-3904

Re: IRS – Status of objection filed 9/3 is unknown as PHS does not address.

Re: Trustee – Objection amended 1/7/09.

PYMT ORDER: Case dismissed with stay through 2/5 @ 4pm for payment of \$200 to be received by the Trustee.

SCHED ORDER: Case dismissed with stay through 2/26 for debtors to –

File a 2nd Amended Plan that resolves point #1, file a 2nd Amended Schedule J that resolves point #2, and provide the Trustee with written responses that resolve points #5, 6, 7 and 11. All points refer to the 2nd Amended Trustee's objection.

Trustee position: The Trustee has **no opposition to a continuance, if the IRS agrees.** If the matter is continued, the Trustee requests that payment and scheduling orders be issued as noted above.

73 – COVARRUBIAS – 08-5-5192

Re: IRS – Per PHS, debtor requests a 120 day continuance in order to provide the IRS with documentation to resolve the pending audit.

Re: Trustee – The Trustee questions debtor’s eligibility under 109(e) due to the IRS claim, in addition to objecting for the term of the plan and for information regarding income.

Trustee position: The **Trustee does not oppose a 120 day continuance** so long as the debtor uses the time to resolve the IRS issue. The Trustee will expect to see significant progress if the lengthy continuance is granted. If there is not sufficient progress in 120 days, the Trustee will file a motion to dismiss for violation of 109(e).

75 – KRESIC – 08-5-5217

Re: Trustee – The only remaining point of the objection is that the Trustee questions whether the provision in Section 7 of the Plan regarding treatment of the claim of Wells Fargo constitutes sufficient notice to the creditor. The debtor disagrees with the Trustee’s position.

Trustee position: The **Trustee will defer to the Court’s discretion** as to whether **plan language** purporting to **strip a mortgage lien** is appropriate or whether the debtor must file a motion or adversary. It should be noted that the plan provides for two different valuations for the residence—section 2(b) values the property at \$519K and section 7 values it at \$500K.
