(a) At the [confirmation](#)ⁱ hearing, the proponent of the [plan](#)ⁱ shall advise the Court when all post-confirmation Court proceedings can be completed. The Court may set deadlines for filing reports and an application for a final decree.

(b) Unless the Court orders otherwise, an application for final decree shall be served on the [United States Trustee](#)ⁱ and on counsel for the Creditors' Committee, or, if there is no Committee, on the 20 largest unsecured creditors. Such application shall be considered by the Court without a hearing, unless within 14 days after the date of service of the notice, a [party in interest](#)ⁱ files and serves a request for hearing.
