² Christmas day will be observed on December, 26 2016, due to Christmas Day falling on a Sunday. **(See 5 U.S.C. 6103(b).)**

³ January 1, 2017 (the legal public holiday for New Year's Day), falls on a Sunday. For most Federal employees, Monday, January 2, will be treated as a holiday for pay and leave purposes. (See section 3(a) of Executive order 11582, it is our policy to always refer to holidays by the names designated in the law. **(See 5 U.S.C. 6103(b).)**
