In the event there are related bankruptcy cases, the debtor shall file a Notice of Related Case(s) at the time the Trustee, other than when filed by ECF. The notice shall list the name, filing date, and case number of any re

The Court may, on its own motion or upon the motion of a party in interest, order a case transferred to another Judge and whether the transfer will promote the efficient administration of the estates or avoid inconsistent or co

(d) Procedure.

A motion by a party in interest to transfer a case or cases shall be addressed to the Judge presiding in the
