(a) Who Shall Give Notice.

Unless otherwise ordered, the initiating party shall give the notices required by Bankruptcy Rules 2002(a)(2) (conversion); (a)(5)[modification of plan]; (a)(6)[applications for compensation], except for final applications

(b) Content of Notice.

The notices given pursuant to paragraph (a) shall fully comply with Bankruptcy Rule 2002(c).

(c) Address List.

Unless otherwise ordered, all notices shall be served on the persons entitled to notice under Bankruptcy Rule 2002(c) and the address list.

Commentary

Attorneys should obtain current mailing list by logging onto CM/ECF, clicking on "Reports" and then "Mailing Lists" to ensure compliance with this local rule.

(d) Service on Committee.

Service on a committee appointed by the United States Trustee shall be made on the committee's counsel or the committee.
