HYBRID AND ZOOM WEBINAR INFORMATION

HYBRID HEARINGS:

The hearing on this matter will take place in-court using hybrid technology. Each party or lawyer can elect to appear in person in court, or remotely by video/telephone. In-person appearances are not required but are optional. The hearing will be conducted in the presiding judge's courtroom 10.

ZOOM PROCEDURES:

- All parties and Counsel who have filed papers in connection with a calendared matter: the Courtroom Deputy will email you an invitation to join the Zoom Webinar two (2) days prior to the hearing. Please make sure your email address is correct.
- Parties or Counsel who have not filed papers but wish to attend the hearing: Please contact the Courtroom Deputy no less than two (2) days prior to the hearing by email at anna_e_lee@canb.uscourts.gov to request an invitation to the Zoom Webinar. The Courtroom Deputy will email you an invitation prior to the hearing. They will attend in LISTEN-ONLY MODE.
- When signing into the Zoom Webinar, please enter **FIRST AND LAST NAME AND CASE NAME**.
- Please sign into the Zoom Webinar **15 minutes early**.
- Do not forward or share the Zoom Webinar invitation with anyone.
- All parties must wear business casual attire.
- Failure to timely follow these procedures may result in a party or counsel's appearance being waived.

PHONE PROCEDURES:

- Parties who dial-in via phone are in LISTEN-ONLY MODE, unless the court instructs otherwise.
- Attorneys and others intending to appear and be heard on matters on the calendar should not register with CourtCall as they had in the past.
